The Litchfield Rugby League Club as we know it today, started out as "The WALLABIES RLC" which existed up until 1965. In 1965 the "WALLABIES RLC" changed to become the "WARATAH-WALLABIES" RLC.

In 1968 the name was changed once again, to become the "WARATAHS" RLC.

It remained as "WARATAHS" RLC until 1984 when it merged with the new junior rural club "SOUTHERN DISTRICTS" and under the merger was known as the "WARATAH-SOUTHERN DISTRICTS" RLC.

In 1990 the club underwent its final transformation to become 'LITCHFIELD"RLC.
